ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP - Any individual who has been a faculty member of a recognized School of Nursing may apply for associate membership. or - Any student enrolled full time or part time in an undergraduate or graduate program in nursing in the Atlantic Region may apply for associate membership. May attend meetings but have no voting privileges.
