Abstract Submission

Abstracts should address the conference theme and fit within one of the following conference objectives:

1. To increase awareness about culturally diverse student learning needs in undergraduate studies
2. To review pedagogical approaches to teaching culturally diverse groups.
3. To apply pedagogical approaches that ensure undergraduate nursing students develop culturally competent skills for practice.
4. To meet educational requirements for a culturally diverse nursing curriculum.
5. To promote the delivery of culturally congruent nursing education to students belonging to diverse cultures

Abstract Guidelines

- Abstracts for oral and poster presentations are welcome in English¹.
- Abstracts must be submitted using the abstract submission form
- Abstracts will be blinded and peer reviewed.
- All accepted abstract presenters must register for the ARCASN Conference and pay the appropriate registration fee.
- Presenters will be notified by Friday, June 29th, 2018
- Presentations will be 25 minutes in length (20 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions).
- Posters will be displayed over the two days of the conference.
