Deadline: April 1st, 2022

Only ARCASN members are eligible to apply for an Educational Development **Criteria:** 

Funds are to be used within 12 months of receiving the award and are not to be used for research. The successful applicants are *expected to* present at the ARCASN conference the following year. If the successful applicants are unable to attend the conference, they *must* submit a brief 1-2-page report documenting the use of the award to the chair of the ARCASN Education

Committee by the end of April 2023.

If an ARCASN Education Committee member(s) applies for an award the member(s) need to declare this conflict of interest in their application and

they will not be part of the awards adjudication process.

Develop a funding request (1000-word limit). Cover letter identifies the **Process:** 

applicants' name, affiliation, address, contact e-mail and phone/fax number.

Applications may be submitted in English or French.

There should be no identifying information on the remainder of the funding request.

Outline of the funding request:

(a) relevance of the request and the contribution to nursing education;

(b) the objectives, outcomes and method in which the project will be implemented, or plan for the development of educational expertise;

(c) how the funds will be used (budget & rationale -1 page limit); and,

(d) plans for sharing the results of the funded project or educational expertise.

Cover letter, budget and references will not be included in the word limit.
